Why Energy Rated Windows?

Our range of double and triple glazed units represent the next generation of high performance technology. We utilise a revolutionary high performance low-E glass, developed specifically for the particular needs of the UK. This enables us to get the highest Window Energy Rating, making our units some of the most energy efficient low-E units on the market.


Our A rated 28mm double glazed units offer up to three times more insulation than standard double glazed units, improving thermal insulation, increasing light transmittance, maximising solar gain, all of which will reduce your heating bills.

Our windows are measured using the **Window Energy Rating** scheme (WER), similar to the white goods in your home, with an "A" rating being the best. Our standard reinforced double glazed windows are A rated as standard, achieving an overall u'value of 1.4 W/m²K (with a glass u'value of 1.2 W/m²K). We are also able to offer a range of triple glazed windows which achieve an overall u'value of 1.0 W/m²K (with a glass u'value of 0.683 W/m²K). Other options are available on request.

How does it work?

Double-glazed windows have two sheets of glass with a 20mm gas filled gap between them, this creates an insulating barrier that keeps heat in. Our triple-glazed windows have three sheets of glass with either 12mm or 14mm gas filled cavities depending on the profile selected. At least one of the panes is made from a specially coated low-e glass, this has an unnoticeable coating of metal oxide which lets light and heat pass into the property but cuts the amount of heat that can get out.

The Benefits of High Security Windows

- ▶ Shoot-bolts with espagnolette locking to most standard sized casement sashes means that the windows are secured in various locking points down the lock side making it virtually impossible to jemmy open
- ▶ Optional claw locks that fit on the hinge side and secure in to steel reinforcing mean that the windows comply with the Police recommended "Secured By Design" security standard
- ▶ Security internally glazed windows which mean that the glass cannot be removed from the outside of the property
- ▶ Laminated glass in vulnerable locations, such as downstairs windows, making the units very hard to break through
- ▶ Optional security bolts to the rear of doors which make the doors almost impossible to jemmy open
- ▶ Anti-bump, anti-drill and anti-snap door barrels are available to give you maximum protection

Low Maintenance

- ▶ No more unsightly flaking or peeling surfaces, the pristine appearance of PVC frames is maintained by an occasional cleaning with a mild detergent such as soapy water
- ▶ No more painting, unlike timber frames our windows, including our range of laminated foils, never need re-painting or re-staining and are guaranteed for 10 years
- ▶ Unlike timber and metal windows which are normally subject to rotting, rusting and corroding PVC is tough and durable and will out-last most other construction materials
- ▶ PVC will not warp, twist or split and providing that you oil the moving parts regularly they will open and close without catching or binding and will remain draught free and weather proof for longer
- ▶ With the introduction of self-cleaning glass you won't even need to clean the external glass surfaces of your new windows

Why choose Tilt and Turn Windows?

A window system specifically designed to maximise the glazing area, enabling larger than normal apertures which aid cleaning as they can be fully opened inwards. As well as this practical feature, tilt and turn windows can provide excellent background ventilation when located in the tilt position.

All of our tilt and turns are fitted with security wrap around gearing which ensures that there are multiple locking points on more than one side. These locate into specially designed keeps, which not only improve the security of the window, but also aid compression and help draught proof the windows.

Many customers choose to use this type of window in conservatories as the glazing area can be maximised to give clear unobstructed views without the need for transom bars.

Tilt and turn windows are also ideal for creating an extra egress point to the upstairs of properties, giving you a clear and easy escape route in the event of a fire.

Features & Options

- ▶ A more traditional looking window, these box sash replacement windows combine an authentic appearance with high levels of performance and durability
- ▶ Old vertical sliding windows relied on weights (balances) secured on rope within the frame to act as a counter balance for opening. Over time these windows often stopped working as excessive layers of paint clogged the mechanisms, also the warping/ twisting and expansion of the wood often meant that the sashes would not run in the wooden rails. The new vertical sliders rely on engineered balances and as the PVC will not warp, twist, or require painting they will work effortlessly for years to come
- ▶ As these balances are screwed in to position you will also lose the sound of the older weights clanking in the frames on windy nights!
- ▶ Glazing options include a feature mounted Georgian bar that mimics the traditional wooden fret bars that were often installed on this type of window
- ▶ The windows come with a tilt mechanism so that they can be opened up internally for the purposes of cleaning rather than having to use an external ladder

Why choose PVC Vertical Sliders?

Many houses in Britain still retain their original wooden sliding box sash windows and for those customers who are trying to maintain the traditional appearance of their homes, we are able to offer a PVCu vertical sliding window which although it looks similar, will out-perform the older traditional box sash windows.

Aesthetics

An authentic appearance, which is enhanced by decorative horns, reflects the elegant looks of the original window, whilst incorporating high levels of performance and durability.

Peace of Mind

Anyone with original wooden sash windows will at some point have experienced difficulties opening and closing them as years of painting and the natural ageing process of the wood causes the sashes to bind against the frames. The modern day PVCu sliding windows will not warp or twist, do not need painting and with just a small amount of care will give you years of smooth and reliable use.

Energy Saving

Once glazed with our high performance units with a u'value for the glass of 1.2 W/m²K our standard reinforced vertical sliding windows attain an A rating, with an overall u'value of 1.5 W/m²K."



Specialist Glass

- ▶ Thermally efficient units are manufactured using glass with an almost invisible coating of metal oxide to retain more heat inside your home, keeping interiors more comfortable in the winter and improving the energy efficiency of your home
- ▶ Solar control units have a special coating that blocks up to 2/3rd of heat by reflecting it to the outside therefore keeping the interior temperature cooler during sunny spells, ideally for south facing conservatories
- ▶ Self-cleaning low-maintenance units which have a coating on the external surface that harnesses UV light and rain to efficiently breakdown and rinse away dirty residues so your windows stay cleaner for longer
- ▶ Noise reduction units are available in a range of different formats depending on your specific requirements. From the basic units which combine glass panes with different thicknesses through to the specialist laminated glass which have transparent plastic interlayers between two sheets of glass which absorbs sound and reduces the levels transmitted, keeping unwanted noise out

As all our products are made to measure to your requirements we are able to offer you a full range of glazing options to complement your home, from the traditional feature Georgian bar that is designed to mimic the external wooden frets through to one off bespoke stained glass feature windows.

We can also supply a wide range of other specialist double and triple glazed units, including a full range of patterned glasses, units with solar control and easy clean coatings, tinted anti-sun units, thermally efficient units with u'values of 0.5 W/m²K as well as specialist units to reduce noise levels.





- ▶ Our doors are secured by way of four outward opposing hooks which prevent the leaf from being lifted from the frame
- ▶ A purpose designed mid-rail provides the ability to incorporate a letter box into the door leaves
- ▶ The patios are available in a wide range of colours and laminated foils to complement the windows
- ▶ The glass is secured into the frames by way of an internal glazing bead, meaning that the glass cannot be removed from the outside, making the doors more secure
- ▶ The patio has a smooth sliding action and comes with adjustable wheels and anti-lift blocks to prevent the leaves from being removed off the tracks

Alitherm windows and doors have been designed to reduce heat loss by the use of a thermally broken aluminium frame with a polyamide bridge.


The polyamide material has a very high resistance to heat transfer from the inner face of the frame (i.e. inside the room) to the external face of the frame (i.e. the outside). Thermally broken frames provide homeowners with windows and doors that have distinct advantages. Strength and durability are provided by the use of aluminium sections which gives structurally sound windows and doors for peace of mind.

Elegant slim sightlines are features of the Alitherm window and doors which are enhanced by an ovolo profile edge appearance. Additionally you have a wide range of colours and finishes to choose from both internally and externally.





